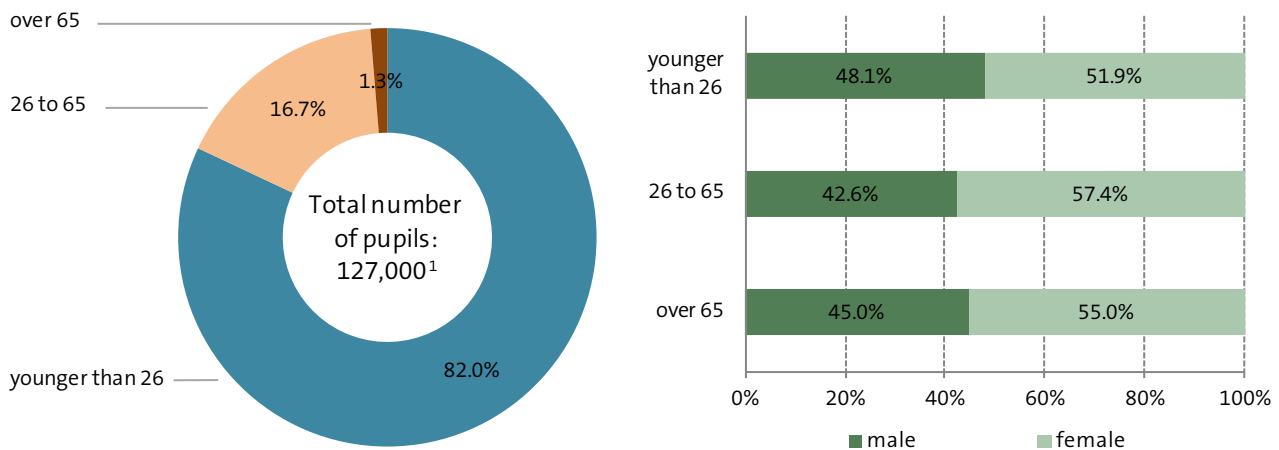
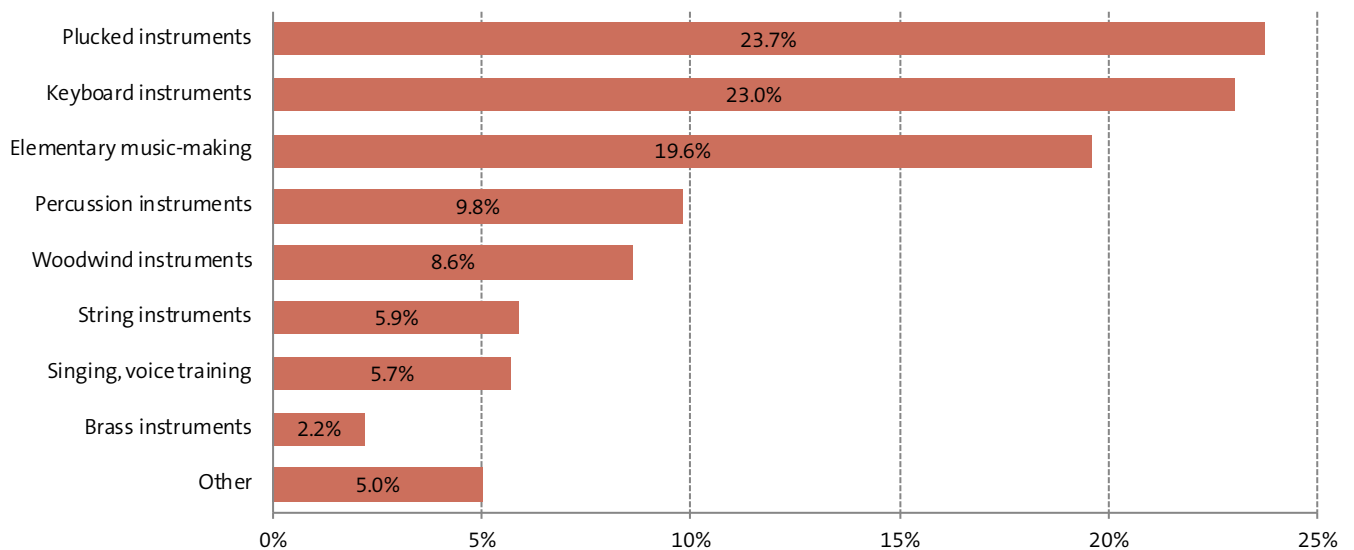


» Age distribution and subject enrolment at private music schools in the National Association of Free Music Schools (bdfm)

The results are extrapolated from the data received (response rate: 36 per cent).

¹ Figures from the bdfm regarding age groups and sex refer to registered pupils, excluding those from co-operating schools. The total number of pupils at bdfm schools in 2016 was 158,000, including 31,000 from co-operating schools.
